









U.S. total market — print and digital


U.S. print genre volume growth


Children's is much less digital than the rest of the book market


Children's and young adult growth

Young adult fiction was down slightly while all other categories grew in print





Children's and YA fiction category growth





Impact of J.K. Rowling


Almost all 2016 growth in children's can be attributed to J.K. Rowling


Children's format growth

Hardcovers, board books, and boxed sets grew while paperbacks declined




How is 2017 stacking up?

Children's sales are soft in Q1 with heaviest losses in children's fiction.




Channel breakdown
